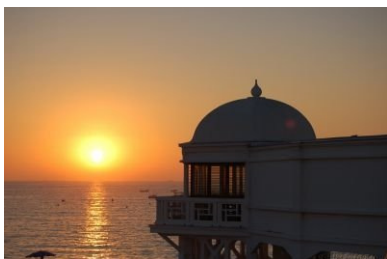
The Oldest City in Spain - **Cadiz**
