## Day 1 Arrival at Bordeaux airport

We will open the doors others cannot, for some great tasting sessions. Lunch in the best spot in Saint Emilion. Stroll in the cobblestone streets and discover gift & wine shops with deluxe items, as well as the famous macaroons. Dinner beside the river in a trendy bistro.

## Day 4 Bordeaux / Paris – Versailles Orientation

Upon arrival on Paris airport, we will drive you to Versailles Palace, residence of the Sun King, Louis XIV. Here, you will discover the famous “A la Francaise” gardens, as well as the Grand Trianon and The Petit Trianon with Marie Antoinette’s Hamlet. And after, we take you back to Paris city centre and follow by a cruise that allowed you to admire the banks of the Seine, which are part of humanity’s world wide heritage. Lunch and dinner in local restaurants.



## Day 5 Paris – City tour

After having been picked up at the hotel, you will be escorted by our guide for a leisure tour of the capital city: Champs-Elysees, The Arc de Triomphe,



Concorde Square, Eiffel Tower, Invalides, Opera Garnier and Notre-Dame Cathedral.

After lunch, we continue to visit one of the largest

museum in the world – Louvre Museum, and in particular its 3 main works: the Venus de Milo, the Winged Victory of Samothrace and the Mona Lisa.
